HOW TO RECOGNIZE AN OVERDOSE

The following are signs and symptoms to look for to identify a potential overdose:

- Loss of consciousness, limp body
- Slowed breathing, choking
- Small, "pinpoint" pupils
- Pale, blue or cold skin
- Slowed heart rate

WARNING:

Naloxone freezes at temperatures below 5°F (-15°C). If this happens, the device will not spray. If naloxone is frozen and is needed in an emergency, do NOT wait for the naloxone to thaw. Get emergency medical help right away.
